DERMAL FILLER REMOVAL AND CORRECTION

WHAT IS FILLER REMOVAL/REVERSAL?

Hyalase (Hyaluronidase) is an enzyme which breaks down hyaluronic acid (HA) fillers. Hyalase acts to

make the tissue between cells more permeable. This allows filler to be rapidly dispersed and

absorbed.

This can be down to your filler results not being as you had hoped, overfill of dermal filler in the area

(i.e., filler migration) or if in case of an emergency.

Hyalase treatment.
